

CURRICULUM

The school employs a communicative and interactive mode of learning. Our educational model is child centred, technology-driven, values-based, activity-oriented and of a superior quality to help prepare students to achieve academic excellence and successfully meet the professional and personal challenges they will encounter.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

In accordance with the Nigerian National Policy on Education, the school runs a six-year programme. This is divided into two sections:

- Early Years Foundation School (EYFS)/ Crèche – this caters to children aged three months to 5 years.
- Key Stage 1/ Key Stage 2 – This spans the next five years which is also known as primary education.
- Key Stage 3 – This spans the first three years of secondary education.
- Key Stage 4 – The next and last three years of secondary education.

KEY STAGE 1 and 2 – PRIMARY EDUCATION

At this stage, pupils are prepared for the Primary Checkpoint Examination which is the Cambridge Assessment International Education (CAIE). Pupils are also prepared for entrance examinations.

KEY STAGE 3 - JUNIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL (JSS 1-3)

The first three years are spent in the Junior Secondary School where they are prepared for the Basic Education Certificate Examination (BECE) of the federal government and the Junior Secondary Certificate Examinations (JSCE) of the state government.

KEY STAGE 4 - SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL (SSS)

At the Senior Secondary School, students are prepared for the following national examinations:

1. WASSCE – West African Senior School Certificate Examinations.
2. IGCSE – International General Certificate of Secondary Education.
3. UME (JAMB) – Universities Matriculation Examinations.
4. TOEFL – Test of English as a Foreign Language
5. SATS – Scholastic Aptitude Tests
