NURSERY & PRIMARY ADMISSION PROCEDURE

SECTION A

1. All inquiries on admission should be directed through the Admin office to the Headteacher.
2. Admissions are open to all classes all through the academic session.
3. The Admission form can be purchased online or on-site from the Admin office in the school. The form is free for the Nursery section while a token of N5,000 only is charged for the purchase of the Primary form.
4. Admissions is based on the age of the child at the point of enrollment as guided by the following:

Targeted Class	Age Group
• Crèche/Cuddly Bear	3 months - 1 year
• Preparatory	1 year - 2 years
• Nursery 1	2 years - 3 years
• Nursery 2	3 years - 4 years
• Reception	4 years - 5 years
• Primary 1	5 years - 6 years
• Primary 2	6 years - 7 years
• Primary 3	7 years - 8 years
• Primary 4	8 years - 9 years
• Primary 5	9 years - 10 years
• Primary 6	10 years - 11 years

Note: Any child who fulfills the terms above would be considered for admission.

SECTION B

Important and required documents for admitting learners:

1. A copy of their birth certificate
2. Two recent passport photographs
3. Medical reports on (a) blood group (b) blood genotype (c) general health report
4. Immunization Records
5. A copy of the last examination report from the previous school attended. This is applicable to the Primary only.
6. Letter of reference from next of kin.

ENTRANCE TEST

Nursery Section

1. Parents/Guardians would be required to bring the Learner for on-site assessment and observation as scheduled by the school.
2. The assessment and observation would be done by the EYFS Coordinator, who will write recommendations objectively and submit the report to the Headteacher.
3. The Headteacher meets the parent/guardian to discuss the child's performance and the decision of the school with them.
4. An admission letter will be issued.
5. The Headteacher directs the parent/guardian that agreed to the school's decision to the Accountant for the school fees and other details
6. The admission letter would be printed as directed by the Headteacher and be presented to the parent/guardian in a file/jacket that contains:
 - a. The school prospectus
 - b. The school fees
 - c. Calendar of events
 - d. List of other requirements etc.

Primary Section

1. Parents/Guardians would be required to bring the children for CBT for KS 2 and paper-based test for KS 1 as scheduled by the school.
2. The entrance test shall cover Numeracy, Literacy, and General Paper.
3. The test shall be conducted in the classroom environment under the supervision of the teacher-in-charge.
4. The teacher-in-charge marks and scores the test.
5. The teacher writes recommendations objectively and submits the report to the Headteacher.
6. The Headteacher meets the parent/guardian to discuss the child's performance and the decision of the school with them.
7. An admission letter will be issued.
8. The Headteacher directs the parent/guardian that agreed to the school's decision to the Accountant for the school fees and other details
9. The admission letter would be printed as directed by the Headteacher and be presented to the parent/guardian in a file/jacket that contains:
